Thank you for your interest in Sweetwater Labradors.

In my breeding program, I believe Labradors should be true to the AKC breed standard as well as free from inheritable health conditions. I place my puppies in wonderful lifelong homes. All of my breeding labs have been screened by Orthopedic Foundation for Animals, have their eye clearances (CERF) & are micro-chipped.

All of my labs are current on vaccinations, heartworm,(Interceptor) & internal parasite preventatives.

All my puppies are whelped and raised in my home, so they are the center of constant attention. They leave for their new homes no sooner than 8 weeks of age. Our puppies are well socialized to include people, children, dogs, toys and water (weather permitting).

Before they leave with their new families, they are vaccinated for their age (we vaccinate at 5 & 7 weeks), wormed for their age (we worm at 2, 4, 6 and 8 weeks). They have had their dewclaws removed. They will have had a 7-week vet check up for any health or congenital problems. New owners receive a puppy folder containing the following: a record of immunization, a schedule, follow-up care instructions, health booklets, a pedigree, copies of parent's health clearances and pictures, and an American Kennel Club registration application.

We recommend you locate a 'puppy kindergarten' class, make contact with a veterinarian and take time to 'puppy-proof' your home and yard prior to your new family member arriving.

All puppies are sold with AKC Limited Registration, which includes a spay/neuter agreement. This means the puppy can not be bred or shown in conformation, but may be shown in obedience, hunting tests, agility and other performance events. We usually have a waiting list for our puppies. We take deposits once the puppies have been born. Anyone interested in a Sweetwater Labrador Retriever puppy must complete an application or contact me by phone.

I understand that completing this application does not automatically entitle me to a Sweetwater Labrador Puppy. I understand that this application is the beginning step in the interview process.
